April 2: Interdenominational walk and service, followed by Stations, 4-9PM.

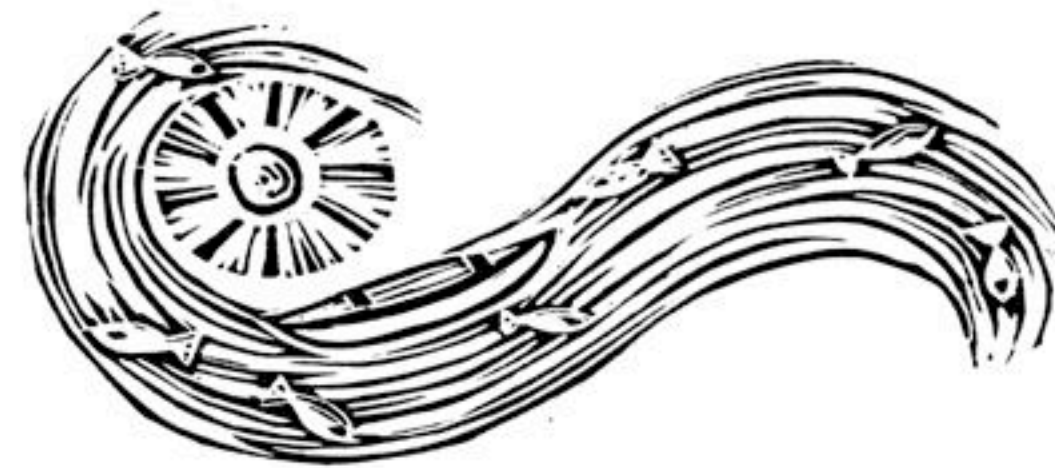
April 3: Easter Vigil 7:00-8:30 at the Stations Exhibit. Special music.
